STEPS TO INFORM OTHERS

DISCUSSION OF PROGRAM TO INFORM OTHERS:

NOTIFICATION POLICIES:

1. As required by 40 CFR 763.93 (G), all parents, teachers/staff and employees organizations shall be notified annually of the existence/availability of this management plan. This information will be communicated in the form of a letter. It will contain information on the availability of the management plan and a outline of the plan including information on inspections, reinspections, locations of ACBM, response actions planned and in progress. (The first notification will be sent out 5-9-89). A copy of this notification will be on file in each management plan.

2. As required by 763.84 (D) all short term workers (e.g. telephone repair, exterminators, etc.) who may come in contact with asbestos shall be notified of the locations of ACBM or suspected ACBM assumed. This will be accomplished by including this information with the purchase order for their services. Also this information should be reiterated during any pre-service or construction meetings. All on site workers will be required to sign a statement individually acknowledging the receipt of this information.

3. As required by 763.95 (A), warning labels shall be attached adjacent to any friable land non-friable ACBM or suspected ACBM assumed located in routine maintenance areas. This will be done by O&M maintenance staff.

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NOTE: The Asbestos Program Manager shall be responsible for implementation of these notification policies and all recordkeeping involved.
